The Chief Estimator will work closely with the sales, engineering, and construction management staff to ensure technical and operating requirements are met in the most cost-effective manner possible.

Duties include, but are not limited to the responsibilities outlined below:

- Review the bid inquiry and ensure the estimate meets technical, commercial and contractual requirements.
- Ensure all estimates are done on time as requested and if there's is a delay, ensure the
 request originator at Wellons is notified and a new expected completion is
 communicated and agreed to.
- Assemble lump sum, budget and detailed cost estimates for the supply and installation of wood-drying kilns, wood-fired energy systems and gas-fired fluid heaters, as well as any other miscellaneous inquiries.
- Develop the scope of work and estimate for all departments (Engineering, Electrical, Manufacturing, Construction and Logistics).
- Solicit subcontractors pricing or bids, understand drawings and specifications, and provide take-out pricing.
- Proof all estimates completed by other estimators, including proofing the estimating summary document prior to submitting to Sales for review.
- Continually develop and maintain the estimating spreadsheets based on feedback after jobs have been completed.
- Maintain comprehensive and accurate records and ensure all estimates are filed in the correct folder and contain the latest information.
- After award, review estimates ensuring current estimate matches what was bid and attend
 project kickoff meeting to share any pertinent information with regards to how it was
 estimated.

- Bachelor's degree in Engineering or related field preferred. Additional certification or advanced degree is a plus.
- Minimum of ten years of experience in working for an OEM.
- Excellent management and communication and collaboration skills, with the ability to work effectively in a cross-functional team environment.
