Typical capital project length ranges from 6 to 18 months.

- Assign work and provide direction to the team based on the contract specifications;
- Select suppliers and equipment based on performance and price;
- Requisition long lead-time items;
- Coordinate work between various internal departments, sub-contractors and the Customer;
- Monitor, control and report the project cost and schedule;
- Provide support to Sales, Shop, Installation and Service departments as well as the customer;
- Visit project sites and address clients concerns when required;
- Maintain the quality, technical and contractual content of the project;
- Generate reports when a site investigation has been completed;
- Manage and oversee Project Managers assigned to specific projects;
- Perform related duties as assigned by the Vice President of Customer Service and Project Management;
